She began her non-profit career in fund development, serving as Director of Development at Seton Hall University and Director of Alumni Affairs and Alumni Fund at Fairleigh Dickinson University.

In addition to her professional experience, Ms. Graeb has been an exceptional leader in Summit's volunteer community. She has served as the Board Chairperson or President of numerous organizations including the Summit High School PTO, Summit Middle School PTO, Summit Free Public Library, Senior Connections Bus Service, the Junior League of Summit and The Connection for Women and Families. Ms. Graeb has also served on the Board of Trustees of the Summit Area Public Foundation and was the recipient of the Junior League's Jean Hudson Gano Community Service Award in 2000.

"I am honored to be joining an organization that has such an incredible legacy of serving the greater Summit community," Ms. Graeb said. "And I look forward to helping with its continued growth and success."
